Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Solon Township Board and Road Committee
January 21, 2003 – 9:30 am

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Gary Johnson at 9:30am.

Board Members present: Gary Johnson, Ken Zank, Elizabeth Mulder, Rich Straub, and Fred Gunnell.

Community Block Grant

Johnson headed discussion. Three years have been accumulated in the Community Block Grant pending the possible pavement of Egner and North Kent Transit.

Johnson also discussed Allocations and Expenditures from July 1, 2000 to June 30, 2003.

Motion was made by Straub to approve the allocations from the fiscal budget years of 2003-2004 \$2000.00 allocated to NKT and \$500.00 to Arbor Circle. Seconded by Gunnell. Roll call vote. Ayes: Johnson, Straub, Gunnell, and Mulder. Nays: Zank. Motion carried, 4-1.

Discussion—Egner

Motion was made by Straub to approve the allocation of funds from the previous approved 2001-2002 road improvements of \$26,000.00, 2002-2003 of \$28,000.00, 2003-2004 \$30,000.00, and 2004-2005 \$30,000.00 for the Egner project. Zank amended the motion to state the pavement will be for the East ½ Egner from Cedar Springs Ave. west and is to be constructed by the Kent County Road Commission as soon as can be completed. Seconded by Straub. Motion carried, 5-0.

Other Business

Mulder made a request that the hourly pay for the Deputy Clerk position she will be filling Feb. 1, 2003 be decided today. Mulder requested 11.50 per hour due to fact that she has 8 years of experience and has completed her Certification as a Municipal Clerk. Her hours would be approximately 10 –15 hour per week. Motion was made by Straub to approve the payment of 11.50/hr for the Deputy Clerk position as of February 1, 2003. Seconded by Gunnell. Abstained, Mulder. Motion failed 2-2.
