

Significant Events and/or Alarms

- Just like 2017 started, calls for service were very high to finish the year. In the month of December, SFD responded to 54 alarms. This is an overall increase of 24 from the average in the month of December. Despite the rise in activity, SFD personnel successfully mitigated all of these alarms without any "turfed" calls. In addition, SFD provided mutual aid four times in December which is nearly double the count of the previous 11 months combined. Kudos to all of the SFD members for sharing this burden and serving the community with dedication and integrity.
- The four mutual aid alarms included two structure fire alarms and a motor vehicle crash alarm with aid given to Sand Lake FD and a medical alarm transferred to Solon FD from Kent City FD.
- Significant time researching equipment and costs to install donated breathing air compressor.
- Building generator ran for approximately 8 hours due to power failure without any complications.

- On December 3, SFD responded 15233 Algoma Avenue on a Structure Fire with auto-aid provided by Algoma, Kent City, and Cedar Springs FD. The owner/occupant had been attempting to burn damp cardboard waste near his barn earlier in the day and left it after it would only smolder. A few hours later he found the fire had spread to his barn. SFD personnel gained a quick knock down on the exterior fire and then moved inside the finished barn to extinguish fire spread. After about 30 minutes of prying and cutting the plywood finished interior walls and ceilings the fire was extinguished. Mutual aid crews were assigned to remove the metal cladding on the rear exterior to extinguish hot spots that spread to the structural members. Damage estimates were set at \$ 10,000.00.
- On 3 different dates in December SFD responded to simultaneous alarms.
- As posted previously, SFD was awarded the purchase of an Automatic Chest Compression Device (ACCD)
 through the generosity of the Firehouse Subs Community Foundation. Recently this equipment arrived
 at SFD, personnel completed manufacturer recommended training, and have added this equipment to
 our cache of tools to provide a quality service to our customers.
