

- As indicated in table above, Alarms with aid provided or received went from zero to seven in March. This coincides with a high alarm volume for March. This activity included SFD providing aid at structure fire alarms in Algoma, Sparta, and Kent City.
- Large grass fire near Saddlebrook development required mutual aid from Algoma and Kent City.
- Students in MFFTC fire academy at Plainfield FD are in the homestretch with the written and practical exam scheduled for the last week of April
- Alarms occurring simultaneously were extremely high this month, including:
 - March 3, medical alarm @ 1135 hours and an illegal burn alarm @ 1144 hours
 - o March 6, structure fire alarm @ 1535, and a medical alarm @ 1537 hours
 - o March 7, medical alarm @ 0513 hours, and a rescue alarm @ 0530 hours
 - o March 16, rescue alarm @ 1832 hours, and a wildland fire alarm @ 1849 hours
