Significant Events and/or Alarms

• Upon request from the City of Newaygo FD, SFD responded to the large wildland fire in Brooks Township on May 1, 2018 @ 1855 hours. SFD responded with three apparatus and 13 personnel for a total man hour expense of approximately 50 hours. This fire has been calculated to have

- consumed 105 acres in and around Brooks Lake. Other agencies involved include all of Newaygo County Fire Agencies, Sand Lake FD, MI DNR Fire Service, and the US Forestry Service.
- A strange event happening this month includes the occurrence of simultaneous alarms six different times in the month of May. Typically, this is estimated to occur once a month at most.
- The air quality tests collected from the Breathing Air Compressor have been tested and approved by 3rd party agency. This means that SFD has obtained the goal of being self-sufficient in the realm of SCBA re-fills. The members will be trained on the operation of the compressor over the next few months. Despite early concerns, the compressor is quiet and very stable on the site selected for install.
- SFD was requested to assist Algoma FD on May 18 on Algoma Avenue @ 0652 hours for multiple building fires at single residential property. This fire was soon determined to be arson by the homeowner. The suspected arsonist later committed suicide at the funeral home on Northland Drive. Other agencies assisting included Sand Lake, Courtland, Cannon, Oakfield, Cedar Springs, and Sparta fire departments and Rockford Department of Public Safety.
- On May 31, the body box for the new SFD Tender 1 was delivered to the vendor in Grand Rapids. All of the compartment doors and lighting will be installed, then removed for painting, and then re-installed for final assembly. The paint vendor is located in Jenison and the box will be shipped next week for painting. For other photos copy and paste:
