Outside of Station Functions/ Significant Events, Alarms:

- FF Schievink provided station coverage on 1-27-20 for 4.0 hours
- On 1-24-2020, SFD was dispatched to 18 Mile just east of Algoma for a car versus tree crash. SFD responded with two apparatus and six personnel. Units arrived to find a heavily damaged two door sedan with the roof of the vehicle crushed against the driver forming a kind of cocoon. SFD extricated the victim in a timely manner using the Genesis cordless extrication tools. The driver exited the vehicle under his own power and was transported to the hospital by Rockford Ambulance with non-life threatening injuries. Mutual aid was provided by Cedar Springs FD. 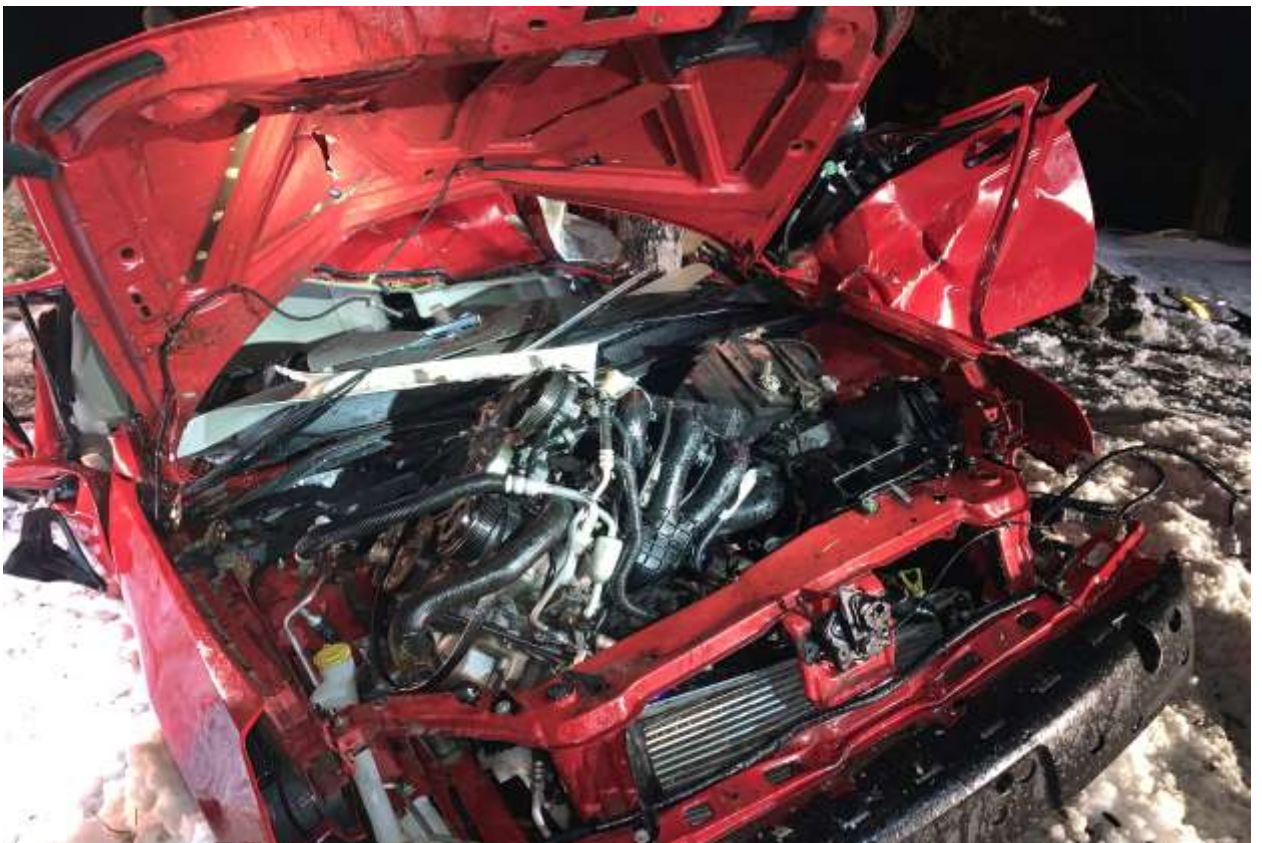
