Approval of Minutes: Motion to accept July 26, 2023, minutes by Sevey, second – Tilburt, all Ayes, carried.

Approval of Agenda: Motion to accept Agenda as presented by Sevey, second - Hoskins, all Ayes, carried.

Public Comment - Matters not the Subject of Public Hearing/Agenda Items: Public comment directed to Agenda items, no comments, public comment closed.

Agenda Items to be reviewed by the Planning Commission:

Agenda Item #1: Scheduled Public Hearing - Ordinance Amendment: Addition of Pet Crematoriums to NC District

Sevey: Called for public comment with explanation of procedures: No public comment, hearing closed.

Sevey: Called for motion to recommend approval of ordinance amendment to the township board. Motion by Tilburt, Second – Sevey. Ayes = 5, absent = 2, motion carried.

Agenda Item #: Scheduled Public Hearing - Special Land Use – Bridge Gate Pet Crematorium – 13470 White Creek Sevey: Called for public comment with explanation of procedures: *(Resident – White Creek Ave.) Complaint about the smell; complaint – why operating prior to approval?

Sevey: No further public comment, hearing closed.

PC Discussion/Questions:

Leisman:

- Addition: Sec. 4(b) Operators
- No hours set for Jeep Armory
- Sec. 3(d), Hours for Pet Crematorium to be 5 am 11 pm, Mon. Sat.; can work <u>inside</u> evenings & weekends as-long-as no sound or smoke created
- Sec. 3(e), addition of no junk vehicles parked outside fenced area shown on site plan by Jeep Armory
- Sec. 3(f), construction of 2 fences to be complete by July 1, 2024; must be 6' high, solid privacy fence
- Sec. 3(G) Chimney emissions and smoke: Crematorium to be operated to prevent noxious/hazardous smoke, soot, fumes, odors, air pollution, particles, or other products of combustion from adversely impacting any neighboring properties.
- Sec. 3(h), only dogs, cats, and other small animals cremated; no storage of carcasses more than 2 hours at a time unless in properly cooled storage.
- PC: Requested Zach Doerr address the odor complaint noted above. (*Doerr*) The initial installation had mechanical issues which have since been corrected by the installing contractor. The issue of operating without approval was due to PC/Zoning misunderstanding during the first review.
- Sevey: Called for motion to recommend resolution, with changes, approving special land use and site plan for pet crematorium, Jeep Armory, and single-family dwelling to the township board. Motion by Tilburt, Second Sevey. Ayes = 5, absent = 2, motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

- 1. Solar Energy Large-Scale Systems Amendment: Reviewed Draft 4 of amendment submitted by study committee dated Aug 23, 2023. Attachment A and Attachment B distributed.
 - Sec. 2 (c) Requirements: (1) project area not to exceed 200 acres
 - Sec. 2 (c) Requirements: (2) total project area in township not to exceed 800 acres
 - Sec. 2 (c) Requirements: (3) addition of, "per project area" to last sentence
 - Sec. 2 (c) Requirements: (20) addition of, "submitted to the Township Board and Township Fire Chief"

Conclusion: Motion by Sevey to set public hearing for September 27th, 7:30 PM. Second – Tilburt, all Ayes, Carried.
