

**TOWNSHIP OF SOLON**  
**COUNTY OF KENT, MICHIGAN**

Public notice is hereby given that the Planning Commission of the Township of Solon, Kent County, Michigan, will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, June 24, 2026, at 7:00 pm at the Frost Creek Church, 15671 Algoma Avenue NE, Cedar Springs, Michigan to hear comments on a proposed ordinance to amend various sections of the Township Zoning Ordinance related to data centers and digital mining uses.

The proposed ordinance would amend the Zoning Ordinance by adding a new Section 3.39 to provide definitions for data centers and different types of data centers, including accessory data centers, small-scale data centers, medium-scale data centers and hyperscale data centers, and to provide additional related definitions. The new Section 3.39 would also provide general regulations for data centers and digital mining, including application procedures, environmental impact assessments, reports, fees, and general regulations for such uses including but not limited to noise, mechanical equipment, setbacks, outdoor storage, water quality, cooling methods, power usage, electrical facilities, lighting, fencing, parking, decommissioning, and other regulations. The proposed ordinance would also amend Section 9.02 of the Zoning Ordinance to clarify that data processing uses included in business services uses permitted in the NC – Neighborhood Commercial District do not include data centers. The proposed ordinance would also amend Section 11.02 to permit accessory data centers and accessory digital mining uses and small-scale data centers and small-scale digital mining uses in the LI – Light Industrial District subject to applicable regulations.

The proposed ordinance would require special land use approval for medium-scale or hyperscale data centers in the LI – Light Industrial District only. The proposed ordinance would also amend the Zoning Ordinance by adding a new Section 16.04 regarding additional standards

and requirements for medium-scale and hyperscale data centers that are required to obtain special land use approval, including additional application requirements, construction regulations, financial security, lot coverage, setbacks, cooling methods, generator regulations, dewatering regulations, liability insurance requirements, inspections, general compatibility, landscaping and buffering regulations, and other regulations for special land use data centers.

The proposed amending ordinance is on file and may be reviewed at the Township Office during regular business hours. All interested persons may attend the public hearing and comment on the proposed amendment. Written comments may be submitted to the Township Office prior to the hearing or at the address above during the public hearing.
