Trustee Hoskins was alerted to the fact their may be PFAS in the area of 16 Mile when someone told him they were getting the run around from the County on not giving them a well permit for a property on 14 Mile. He contacted the Kent County Health Department who directed him to EGLE, who then directed him to the City of Cedar Springs. The area of contamination is the old sewer lagoon in the City of Cedar Springs. The City Manager provided maps where properties near 16 Mile and White Creek were tested, with a few showing higher than normal amounts of PFAS. According to the Kent County Health Dept, residents were notified. To ensure residents were notified, we will try and reach out the KCHD for a copy of the letter sent to make certain residents are aware.
